# **Budget**

## **PROJECT COSTS**

This Reconnecting Communities Capital Construction grant request seeks to convert the existing Spokane Transit Authority (STA) Route 25 to bus rapid transit (BRT) service. The grant request is for construction activities only. Ongoing design and environmental activities are funded locally.

#### **Budget, Level of Design, and Cost Estimate Source**

Future project costs total \$100.9 million in 2028 (midpoint of construction) dollars. STA has contracted with an engineering design consultant to complete the engineering and cost estimates for this project. **The construction cost estimate is based on 30% design plans,** and therefore some cost items may change as design progresses. Costs have been inflated to 2028 dollars to account for likely labor and materials cost increases.

Table 1 summarizes estimated project costs. Final design is expected to be complete by April 2026. A 30% contingency is included in the cost estimates to account for unforeseen items.

### SOURCE AND AMOUNT OF FUNDS

#### **RCP Grant Funding Request**

STA will contribute 50.5% of the total project costs (\$50.92 million) as a local match. Table 2 presents the project budget by funding source.

STA's matching funds will come from our share of \$12,520,000 local funds, combined with \$38,400,000 million of state Move Ahead WA funds. Both of these are funding sources dedicated or programmed to Division Street BRT project.

Division Street BRT <u>Construction and Implementation</u> (page 1303) is programmed in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The Project Development phase is listed as a Completed Project (fully obligated funding) in SRTC's Transportation Improvement Program (<u>TIP</u>) for 2023-2026 (page 12). For the 2024-2027 program, the SRTC <u>TIP</u> also includes the Division Street BRT Construction and Implementation phase (page 23).
